MOISTURE AND OSPREY 2

As you probably know, the principal enemy of a wooden airplane is moisture and water. I strongly believe that every possible way the water can go in "must" be sealed.

On my plane, I used the same rubber boot on the main landing gear retracting rod and the elevator push rod I am in the process of adapting the same boot to nose wheel retracting rod. It is also important after sealing the tail, to supply an opening for proper mounting of the airfrane. For this, but a hole in the top vertical section of the tail spar and cover it with a special grommet to prevent any water going in. The hole has to be about one (1) inch diameter and the grommet to be seaplane type with the opening towards the bottom of the rudder.
