I want to thank you so much for the fine job you are doing in bringing to us the Osprey Newsletter.

The newsletters have provided a great deal of information about the Osprey and those who are building it. I have used three ideas of modification taken from the newsletters - centerline rudder cables - Jeff Fraisure landing gear assist springs from a Mustang car and using the Torrington ball busing for the landing gear top axle.

I have completed almost everything up to the landing gear drawing #27 at this time. Many of the brackets have also been completed on remaining pages of plans.
